



Draw a Picture

Draw a picture to help you solve the problem.



Count Ahead

Finger Counting



$$3 + 2 = 5$$

Use your fingers to count to help you solve the problem.


Make a 10

$$9 + 4 = 13$$

$$\begin{array}{r} +1 \\ \hline 10 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} -1 \\ \hline 3 \end{array}$$


$$\ggggg 10 + 3 = 13$$



Make the largest
number a 10.

Count On

$$4 + 3 = 7$$



5, 6, 7

Start with the larger number and count on from there.

Flip Flop

$$2 + 4 = 6$$


$$4 + 2 = 6$$


Numbers can be added
in any order.

Friend of 10

1	2	3	4	5
9	8	7	6	5

Memorize the 10's partners to help make these problems easier.

Adding Zero

$$7 + 0 = 7$$

When you add 0, the number you are adding does not change.
