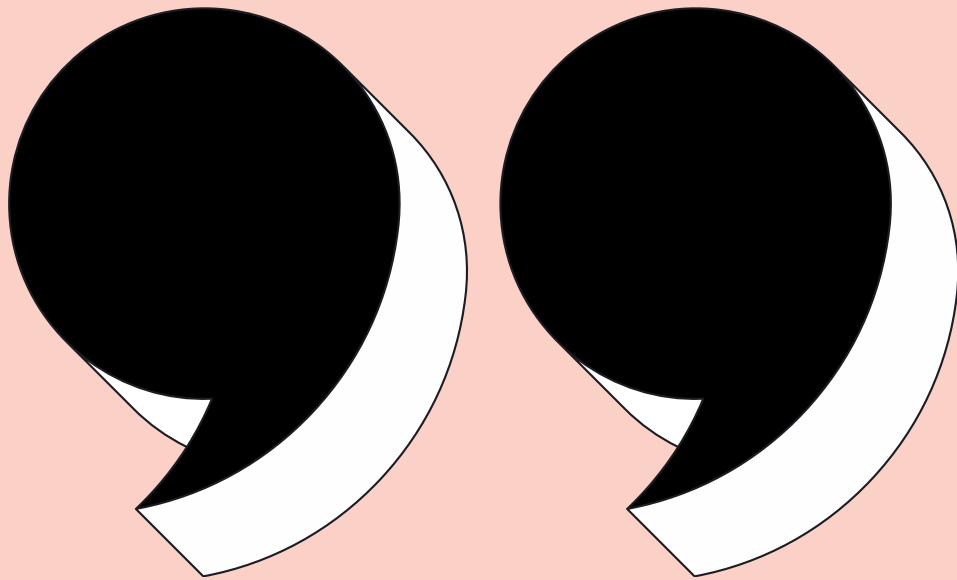
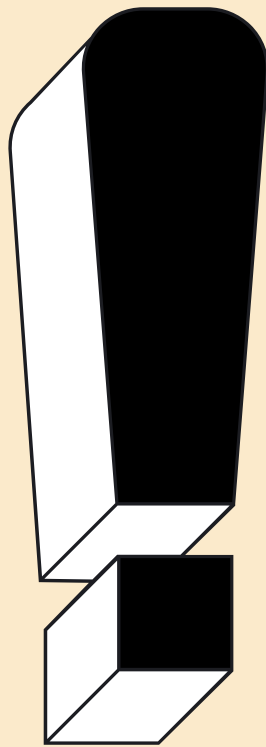


QUOTATION MARKS



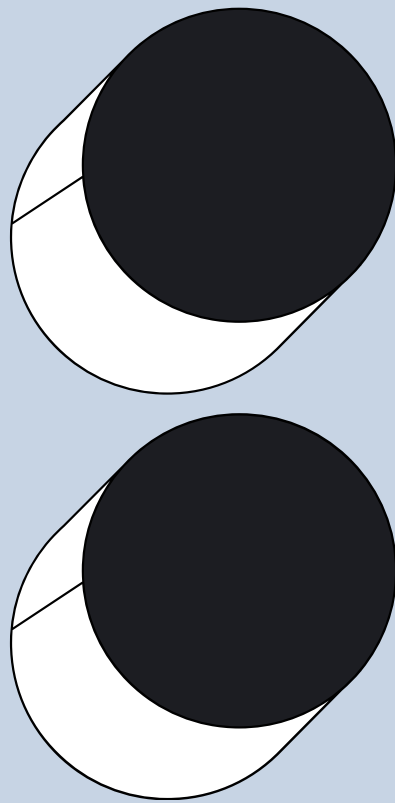
Used to indicate direct

COLON



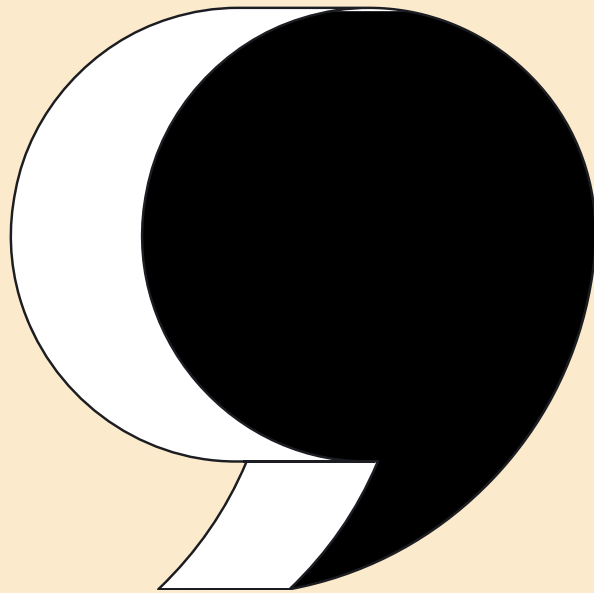
Used for correcting, or

COMMA



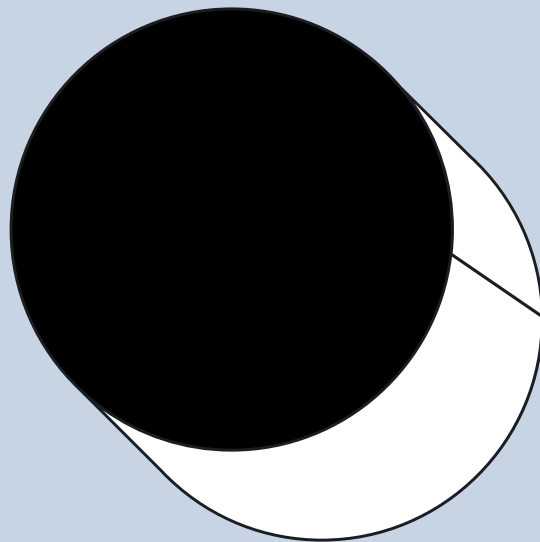
Used to separate items in a list or to indicate a pause.

FULL STOP



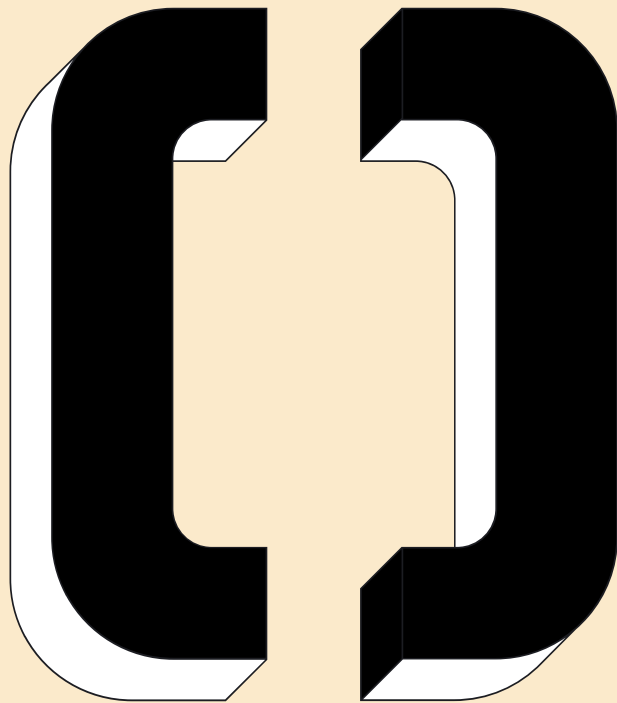
Used to indicate the

PARENTHESIS



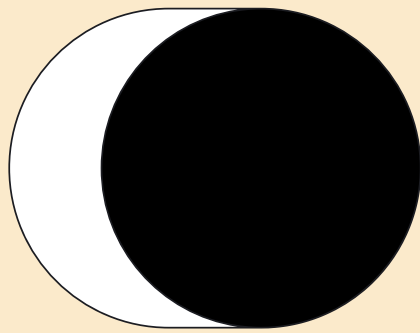
Used to enclose

AT SYMBOL



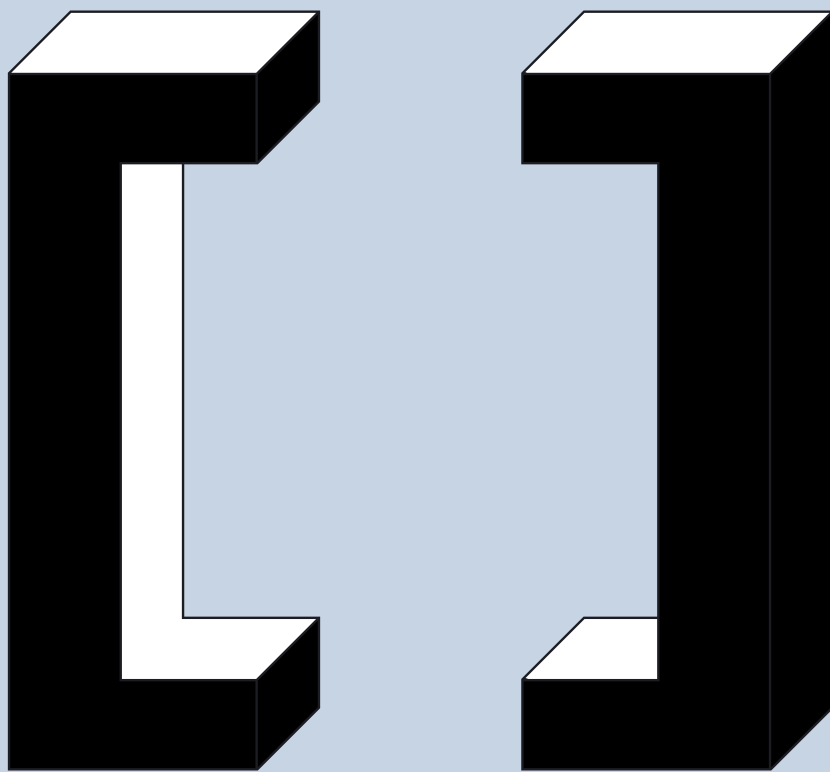
Used for email addresses and social media accounts.

SEMICOLON



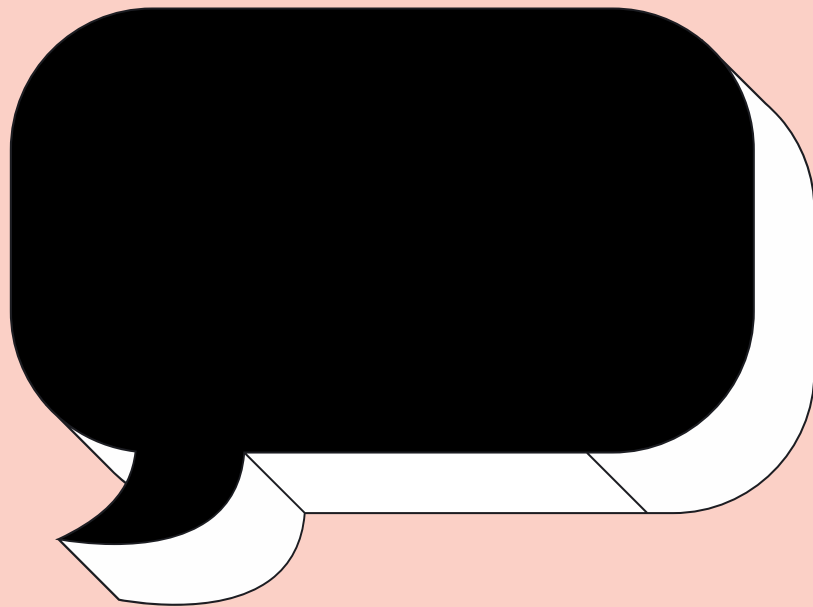
Used to join closely related independent clauses.

BRACKETS



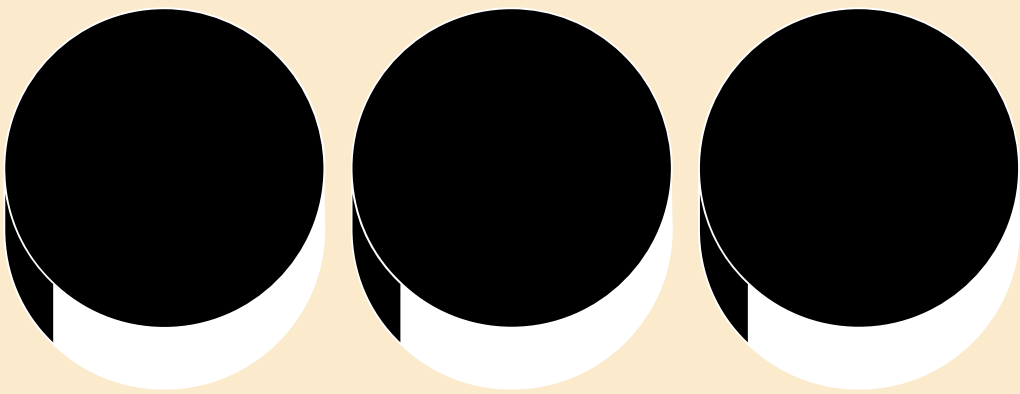
Used for extra or corrected information in a sentence.

SPEECH BUBBLE



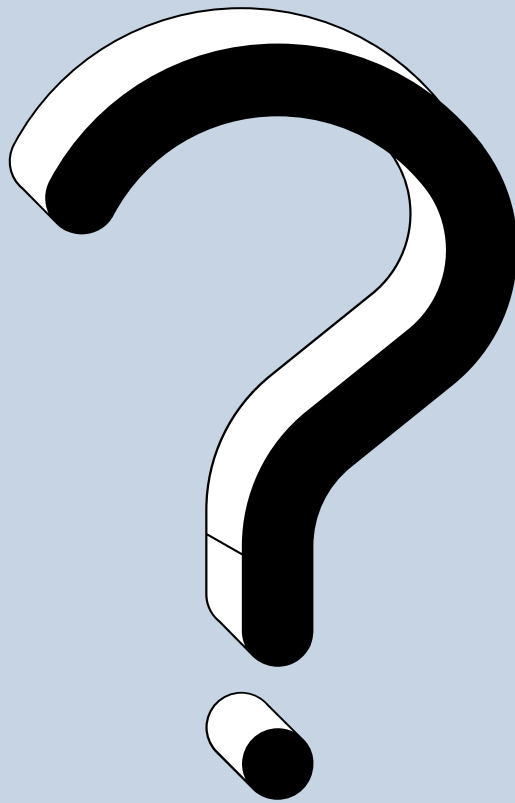
Used in comics and cartoons to indicate dialogue or speech.

QUESTION MARK



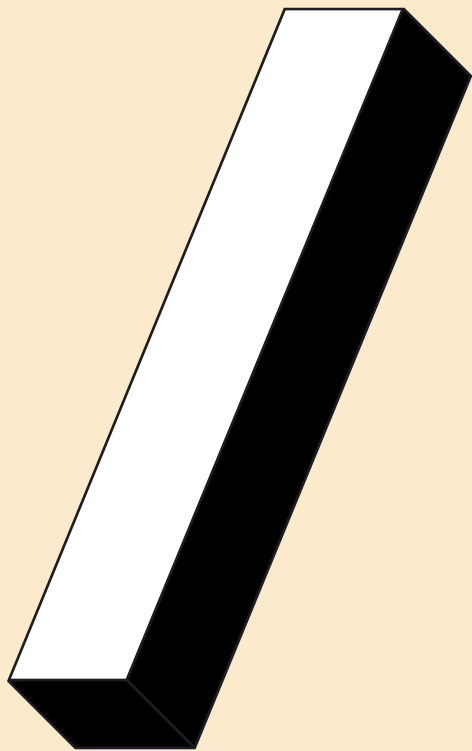
Used to indicate the presence of a direct question.
