


Root

The roots anchor the plant, absorb water and nutrients, and transport it to the rest of the plant.



Stem

The stem provides support, transports the nutrients up to the rest of the plant, and stores food.



Flower

Flowers attract pollinators
and are also responsible
for producing seeds.




Leaf

The leaves produce food through a process called photosynthesis.



Seed

A seed contains all the necessary nutrients to grow into a mature plant.



Fruit

Fruits protect and disperse
the seeds of a plant.
