

ROMAN NUMERALS

Roman numerals use seven capital letters to represent values.

I	→	1
V	→	5
X	→	10
L	→	50
C	→	100
D	→	500
M	→	1000

Numbers are formed by combining symbols, adding from left to right or subtracting when a smaller value precedes a larger one. No zero exists in this system.

For example:

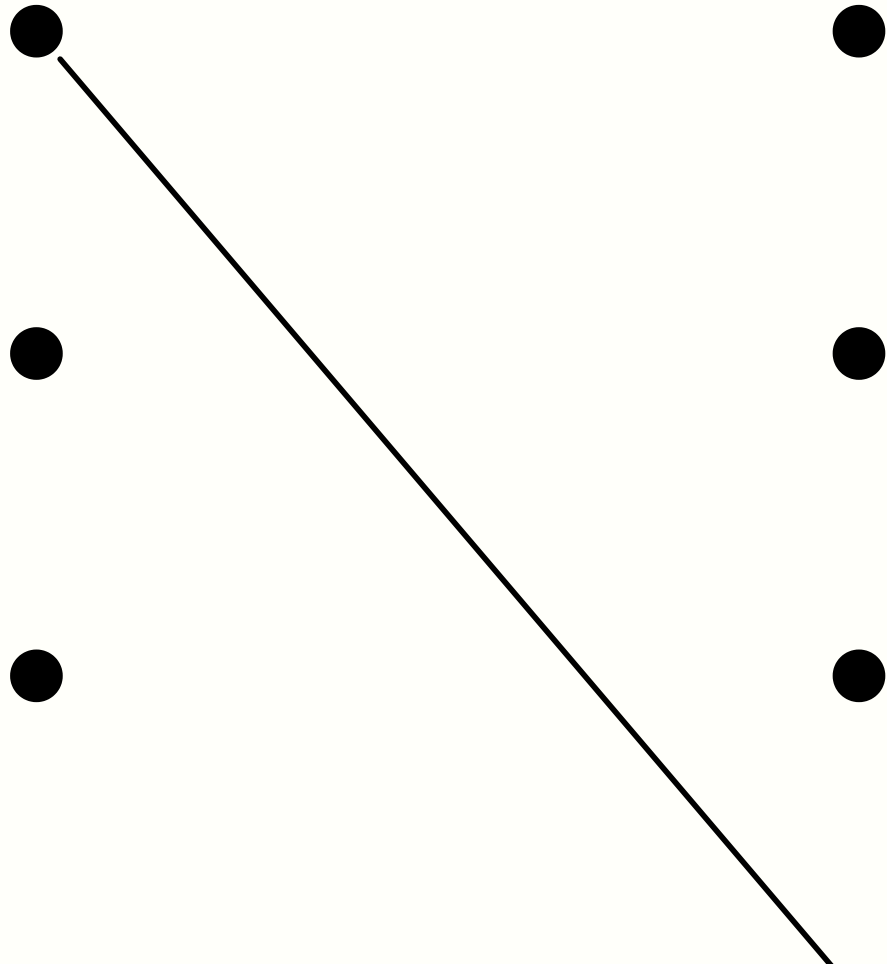
